He also served as President of both our local and the Council of New Jersey State College Locals. He was dedicated to his students and a great champion of unionism on all levels. After his death, a \$1,000 per year scholarship was established in his name and the requirements have recently been revised.

The new requirements are:

- 1) For full time NJCU undergraduate students
- 2) Must have at least a 3.3 GPA
- 3) Must submit a 3 to 4 page essay on some aspect of the American labor movement
